

Spotlight on Naked Leathers

Spinneybeck naked leathers are produced from the finest, purest raw materials possible. With hides obtained from Italy, Southern Germany, and Denmark, these leathers benefit from a moderate climate plus containment and management methods that do not cause visible injury to the animals and offer a far better yield.

Full grain leather has no surface alterations as the hide's natural pores and grain textures are intact. A pure aniline dye is applied with no surface finish so the natural characteristics, which are inherent and unique to every hide, are visible. These characteristics (such as fat wrinkles, neck wrinkles, and backbone markings) are not flaws, but desirable natural features of the product.

Another aspect of naked leather is that as a natural product it will develop a beautiful patina with age and usage. It will wear in verses wearing out. These leathers should be selected explicitly with these characteristics in mind.
